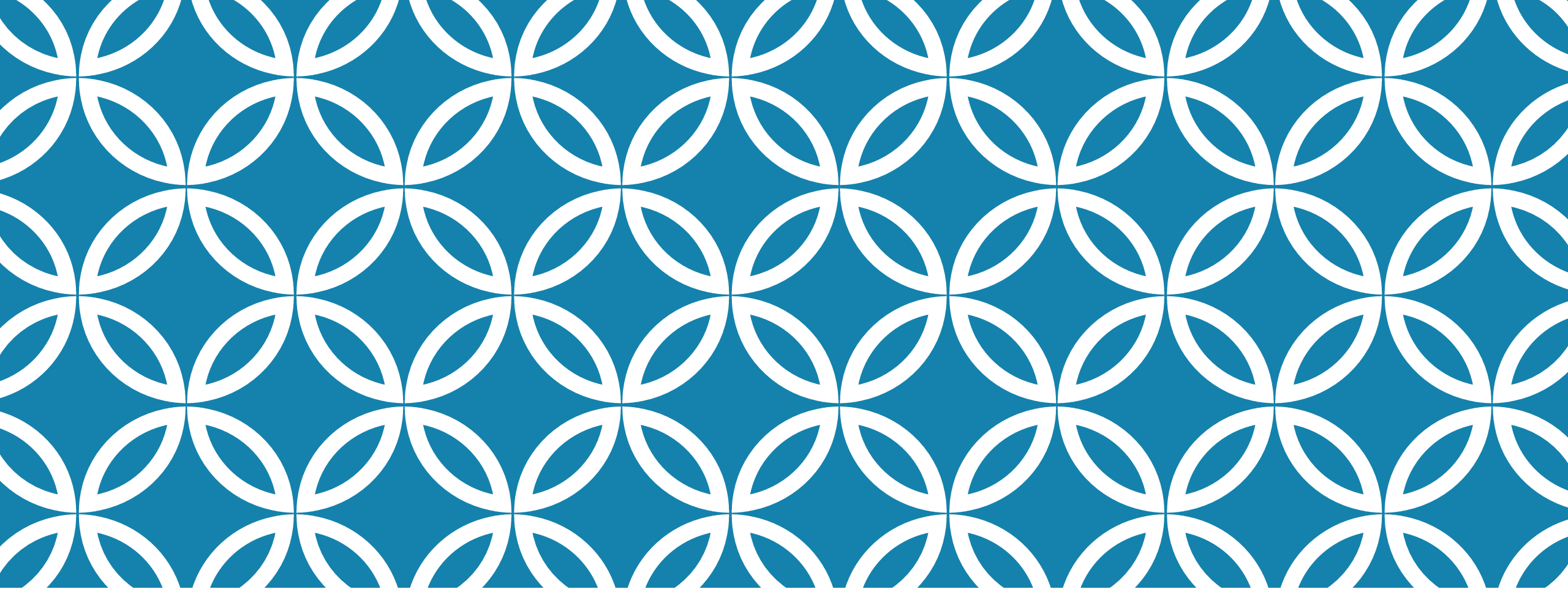
**Diversity and originality are key**, so encourage pupils to think beyond the well-known. Underwater caves? Wonderful constellations? The sky is the limit - literally!

# TAJ MAHAL



- In India
- 388 years old
- Tomb of the Emperor Shah Jahan and his wife Mumtaz Mahal

# COLOSSEUM



- In Italy (Rome)
- 1940 years old
- Built by Emperor Titus to hold entertainment like gladiators and chariot racing.



# GREAT WALL OF CHINA

- In China
- 2,720 years old
- Built to protect China from nomads who would raid villages.

# PYRAMIDS OF GIZA



- In Egypt (Africa)
- 4,600 years old
- Built as tombs for powerful and wealthy Ancient Egyptian Pharoes
