Our range of pupil and whole family events allow us to celebrate progress and achievement so that children recognise their success and celebrate that of their peers.

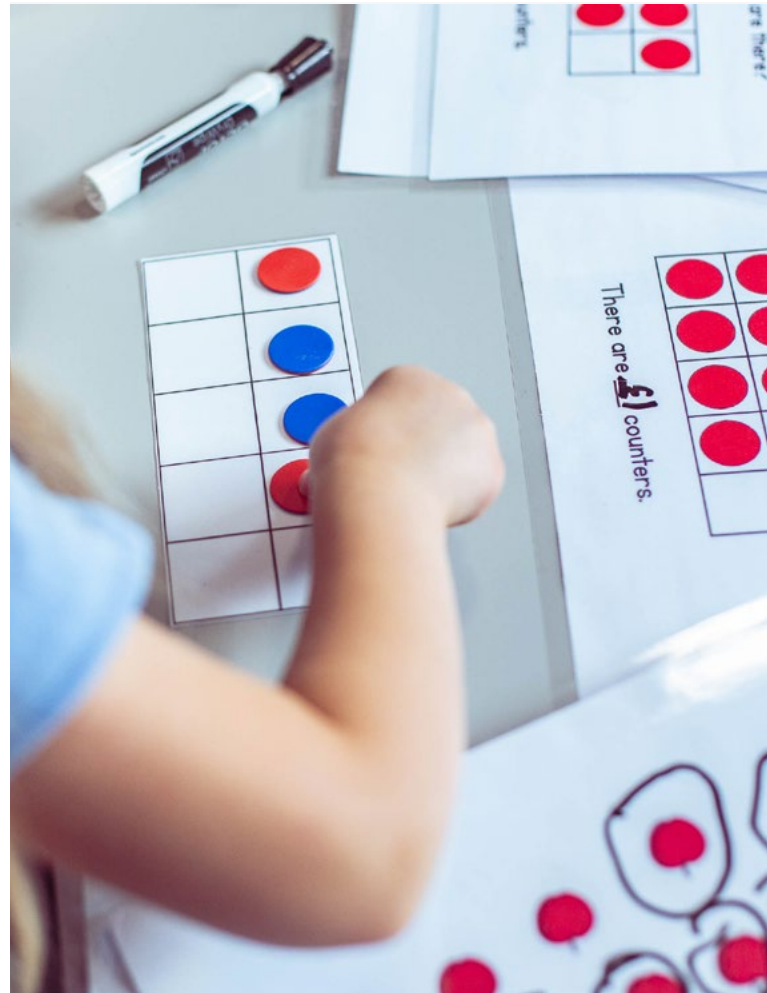

Our assemblies ensure that children learn about keeping safe, about local opportunities and causes, and the joy of celebrating our own and others' success in our learning!

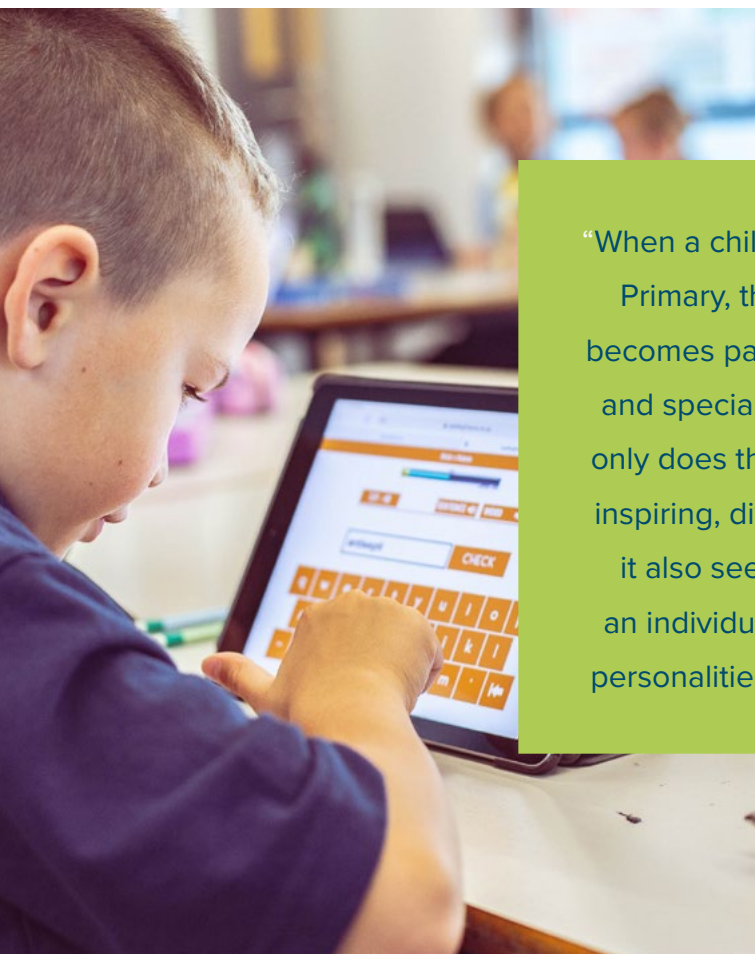
School Visits
