Y1 Phonics	Y2 Spag – see our daily videos to help!
<p>There are daily phonics videos for children in green and pink phonics groups as they are learning new sounds – please check your emails to see which one your child needs to watch.</p> <p><b>Green Group</b> sounds this week are <b>ay</b> and <b>ee</b>.  Monday – reading with ay  Tuesday – spelling with ay  Wednesday – reading with ea  Thursday - spelling with ea  Friday - consolidation</p> <p><b>Pink group</b> sounds are <b>ea</b> and <b>oi</b>  Monday – reading with ay  Tuesday – spelling with ay  Wednesday – reading with ea  Thursday - spelling with ea  Friday - consolidation</p> <p><b>Everyone</b> - keep practising the sounds at the front of your 'phonics homework book'.</p> <p><u>Spellings for Blue and Orange phonics groups:</u>  Each week I will list 8 words to practise at home. You could even have a little spelling test at the end of the week! Sometimes it easier to choose a few to practise the first 2 days and then build up more as the week goes on.  This week's words are: <b>The /v/ sound at the end of words spelt with 've'</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"> <b>have</b>  <b>live</b>  <b>give</b>  <b>love</b>  <b>glove</b>  <b>above</b>  <b>nerve</b>  <b>behave</b> </p> <p>Once learnt please encourage your child to use the correct spelling of these words in their writing.</p>	<p>Monday: -less  Add the suffix to the root words: <b>pain harm thought care</b></p> <p>Tuesday: -less  Add the suffix to these root words: <b>Home spot taste heart</b></p> <p>Wednesday: -less  Read the words: <b>Speechless powerless useless endless</b></p> <p>Thursday: -less / -ful  These are the root words: <b>hurt wire clue use harm</b>  Which can have the suffixes added to them?</p> <p>Friday: how spellings can change when the root word ends with the letter 'y'  Root words: <b>mercy penny beauty plenty merry</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Year 2 spellings to practise this week:</u></b></p> <p>Most children are ready to begin learning how to spell the Year 2 common exception words. Each week I will list 8 words to practise at home. You could even have a little spelling test at the end of the week!  Sometimes it easier to choose a few to practise the first 2 days and then build up more as the week goes on.  This week's words are:  <b>door floor poor kind mind behind find whole</b></p> <p>Some children are already spelling these words and were going to be learning alternative spelling patterns. (I will contact these parents to let them know!) This week's spelling patterns are <b>g / ge / dge</b> and the words are:  <b>edge bridge huge village magic gym giant cage</b></p>

You will be able to write this too.

You could test out different materials to find the strongest, such as a paper house or a marshmallow house or even a spaghetti house! You could use things found outside such as rocks or twigs too. Let us see your houses please!
