Show that number with your fingers.</p> <p>Rainbow challenge – bring your dinosaur to zoom tomorrow and make him say 6.</p>	<p>World book day. Read the story that got the most votes.</p> <p>Revise sounds f e l h r. Look at Mrs Exley's writing and see if you can find f e l h r</p> <p>Rainbow challenge – Read lots of stories with your grown up in lots of different places around your house and garden. Which is the funniest place you can find? Perhaps you could send us a picture.</p>	<p>Revise sounds j v y w z q x. Mrs Exley's hand has turned into a dinosaur and he's hungry. Feed him the sounds.</p> <p>Look in our story at the T-Rex reflection. Talk about a reflection.</p> <p>Rainbow challenge – find a mirror in your house and look at your reflection. Pull funny faces. Can you make a dinosaur face? What kind of face can you make?</p> <p>Bring your special book to school on Monday, if you want to show us your work.</p>
Session 2	<p>Make a dinosaur swamp, like in our story. You need a bowl, some rocket lettuce or similar and some water. You may have some toy dinosaurs that could swim in the swamp. Keep your swamp somewhere safe when you have finished playing.</p>	<p>Make a bridge to go over your swamp. You can build it with anything you can find but it must be long enough and strong enough for Mummy and Daddy dinosaur.</p>	<p>Use pegs to attach to your laminated dino and count the pegs. If the pegs say 4, put the dinosaur next to number 4 on your number line.</p>	<p>Draw a dinosaur in your special book or use a printed outline of a dinosaur and make the dinosaur's skeleton by sticking cotton buds on to the dinosaur. Show on zoom tomorrow.</p>	<p>Cut up one of your dinosaur lotto sheets. Cut the other sheet in half to make 2 cards. Then play the game. Match the dinosaurs. Turn one over and put it on your card if it matches. Who fills their card first?</p>
