Dear families,

Welcome to our latest newsletter. This weekly newsletter is the best place to keep abreast of all that we offer in school and the latest news.

Music Tuition: We have been informed by Barnsley Music Service that the cost of music lessons will increase slightly from £53 to £54.50 per term. Instrument hire remains the same at £15 per term where applicable. We hope that lots of pupils will continue their music tuition in September 2021 and we will have space for some new recruits so please get in touch with Miss Chapman in the school office if you wish to put your child's name on the waiting list for any instruments. We currently have music teachers offering lessons for: keyboard, drums, guitar, ukulele, flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, French horn, violin, cello and double bass.

Y6 Bubble Closure: We were devastated to have to close our Y6 bubble last week (on Tuesday). This was our first bubble closure in 9 months but it reminds us of the need to stay alert. Could we remind all parents of the importance of face masks, following the one way system and minimising contacts (e.g. please arrive at the correct times and only one adult to collect per child). Well done to Y6 families, pupils and staff for adapting so quickly and moving our learning online. The children can return on Friday this week. We can't wait to see them again!

It is important that we keep to times to ensure fairness for all and that we do not have a build-up of parents waiting in the hall, etc. **If you have any concerns or sensitive issues to discuss please make an appointment on a separate evening.**

Improvement update: Despite the very usual year in school, recent reviews of school data and observations show that all areas of school are operating well. Leaders and teachers are working together to continue to make improvements and ensure that we are keeping standards high or raising them where required. We are starting to shape our improvement plan for next year which will include a big focus on further COVID boosting/support, developing the outdoor provision further in KS1 and having the highest expectations and support for all readers.
