



Friday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2021

Dear Parents/Carers

Class 5 will be going on a day trip to Scarborough on **Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021**. We shall need the children in school for **7.15am**, as we will be leaving at **7.30am**. We will be leaving Scarborough at 3.30pm and expect to be back at school by **5.30pm**. **If the weather is really bad we may leave Scarborough earlier**. If there are any changes we shall inform the school, who will send out a text to let you know. Please collect your child from the playground and we shall let the children out one at a time through our class 5 cloakroom door. Please socially distance and wear a facemask to collect-only one parent per pupil please.

This trip fits in with our Summer Term Topic of: The Coast. During this topic the children learn all about the North East Coast of England including: coastal erosion, the history of Scarborough, building sea defences, environmental issues and wildlife. This trip helps the children to consolidate their learning and helps them when they get back to school to complete some excellent pieces of writing, art and topic work.

During our day trip the children will get the opportunity to learn about the history of Peasholm Park, walk from the North Bay to the South Bay, visit the life boat centre, complete a beach study and visit a sea side shop. You can send your child with some spending money-please do not send them with more than £5. They will get the opportunity to use some of this money to buy an ice cream from the Harbour Bar-if they wish to.

This trip relies heavily on the weather-as the entire day will be spent outdoors. **Therefore they do not need to wear school uniform**. Please dress your child according to the weather-e.g. if it looks like rain please make sure they have a raincoat. If it is going to be hot and sunny-please apply sun cream and send them with it so they can re-apply, and make sure they have a hat and their shoulders are covered. **They will definitely need to wear comfy and appropriate shoes, as they will be doing a lot of walking**. We will not have any facilities to support them if they find they cannot walk in the shoes they have brought.

**The children will require a packed lunch if they have not ordered fish and chips**. Please send them with either water or squash and a healthy snack. **The school cannot provide any lunches for this trip, due to our early start.** .

**Therefore they will need a suitable backpack to carry their lunch/drink/snack in, as well as their purse and possibly their sun cream.**

**If your child is travel sick please give them travel sickness medication before they travel and provide school with their medication for the return journey-this is very important.**
