Scooter Skills Sessions: Friday 10th December 2021

On Friday 10th December, Springvale Primary School are holding Scooter Skills Sessions!

We invite every child to take part and to bring their scooter to school **if they have one**. Children may need to share their scooter with those who do not have one.

The aim of these sessions is to improve children’s confidence and stability when riding their scooter, with the aim of them being able to scoot to school safely. The children will be learning how to use their scooter safely and take part in learning about passing pedestrians and crossing roads safely through a course set out.

Children will need to wear a helmet for this activity and if they normally wear knee/elbow pads and you would like them to wear these on the day, please send this safety gear with your child.

The scooter skills session lasts for around 30 minutes, so please ensure your child dresses appropriately. The session will be delivered by Barnsley’s Active Travel Officer, Ami Harding.
