

Tuck Shop Trial

Our School Council have often asked about setting up a tuck shop...

So, next half term we will be introducing a tuck shop on a Wednesday, during morning break. The tuck shop will be open for years 1 to 6. Children will be allowed to bring 50p to buy a snack at playtime if they wish. They will be responsible for their own money so it would be a good idea to encourage them to keep it in a coat pocket or in a safe pocket in their bag. Money should NOT be handed in to teachers or the Main Reception.

The tuck shop will promote a balanced diet, healthy choices and being environmentally friendly (no plastic).

Examples of snacks that might be available are:

- Scotch pancakes
- Malt loaf
- Dry Cereal
- Dried/fresh Fruit
- Cucumber/Carrot sticks
- Breadsticks

We would like the children to be independent when using the tuck shop. They'll learn to be responsible for their own money. Children will help set the tuck shop up, sell items, work out costs/profits and report this to school council half termly. All profits will go to school funds.

The tuck shop will be out during the Springvale Museum evening for people to come and try and ask any questions.

We will be trialling this for half a term and we will welcome feedback, before deciding whether to continue with it or not.
