Dear families,

We hope everyone has had a wonderful Summer break! We cannot wait to welcome you back tomorrow! A reminder that our school day starts at 8.40am and finishes at 3.10pm for EYFS pupils (unless part time nursery, see specific timings on letters and please note the staggered start to this first week for the F2 pupils). The school day runs from 8.45am to 3.15pm for Y1-Y6 pupils. A reminder that the new F2 group start tomorrow and will be here from 8.40am to 12noon tomorrow and Wednesday, then 8.40am to 1.30pm on Thursday and then all day on Friday.

**Milk update:** We were informed on the final day of the Summer Term that our milk provider was ceasing trading so we have found a new provider for the new school year. We have worked hard over the summer to get a milk provider in place for this first week and have just missed the deadlines with our new company, Cool Milk. Very shortly you will receive an email with details of how to sign up and pay for milk from Miss Chapman or Mrs Armitage. If you sign up by Tuesday at 5pm the milk will start next Monday. This is then also the case for every following Tuesday at 5pm for delivery from the next Monday. We're disappointed to miss the first week but assure you that we have done all we can over the Summer break after hearing about the milk company ceasing to trade at 3pm on the final day of last term! Pupils who are entitled to free milk through age or entitlement will start to receive it from Monday.

Please note that only Y2 and Y6 will be having a lesson tomorrow so they are the only classes that a require a PE kit on the first day. Please ensure that pupils have some trainers or suitable footwear in their PE kit as lots of it will be outdoor during the year when possible.

**Sun-cream:** After 6 weeks of rain the sun is back out! Please remember to follow our sunscreen policy carefully and apply a healthy amount before school as well as sending in named bottle to apply at lunch. We also encourage sun hats and water bottles- which can be filled during the day. If your child is new to school and you haven't filled in the sun screen permission slip please do so ASAP.

**Leadership Update:** A reminder that our leadership structure has now changed. Mr McClre is now Executive Headteacher over Springvale and Oxspring and Mrs Fearn will be the Head of School at Springvale. With this in mind please ensure that all emails are sent through the <u>office@springvaleprimary.org</u> email address from now on so that they can be passed on to the most suitable person. A reminder also that the system for discussing school matters should be class teacher first, then Head of School and then myself. Either myself or Mrs Fearn will endeavour to be present on the playground or around reception for each morning drop off and afternoon pick up should you need us.

## News nuggets:

- Spelling- we are moving away from weekly spelling tests in most classes this year and completing spelling
  patterns and key words in class. The high frequency and key spellings for each year group will be in learning
  logs to master throughout the year.
- A final reminder to send any updates to your safe collection list or permission to walk home by the end of today please! They will be emailed to staff at 6pm today and cannot be changed until Christmas after that time.
- A reminder that Y3 pupils now have to pay for lunches unless they receive Free Schools Meals.
- Some key dates to be aware of for this year. These are especially important for pupils in Year 1, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6. All pupils in Year 1, and those in Year 2 who did not previously meet the pass mark, will need to complete their 'Phonics Screening Check'. This must be completed between Monday 10<sup>th</sup> and Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June. All pupils in Year 4 complete a 'Multiplication Check'. We have a specific time scale where this needs to be completed and for 2024 this will be from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> until Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June. The dates for Year 6 SATs for 2024 will be Monday 13<sup>th</sup> until Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May. Please note that it is imperative that all pupils attend every day as they will sit a different test each morning of this week, apart from Friday. All of these tests are statutory and therefore it is vital that all pupils are in school and can complete the tests on time, if not, then this could have implications on their future teaching and learning.
- A reminder that our clubs will launch on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September at 2pm! A few of our regular clubs are taking a break this half term to allow staff to settle in to new roles and responsibilities but they will return soon! The list is attached so that you can take a look before the bookings open! A reminder that pupils who are Pupil Premium can access one school based club each half term for free.
