Dear families,

Welcome to our latest newsletter. We are just three weeks away from the big day now and every remaining day is packed with exciting learning and special events to take us through to the festive fun! We continue to be absolutely delighted and amazed by our wonderful levels of behaviour and attitudes in school! Another 100% green week last week! Well done everyone! Recently we have had 15 children, all girls in Y3, take part in a dodgeball competition at PGS which was so much fun! Well done to everyone involved! Our attendance also remains very high- we have sent out texts to all children with attendance below 96% so that families are aware and can keep attendance high. Please remember that attendance below 90% represents persistence absence which is monitored by Educational Welfare Officers as well as the school. Every day is crucial and over the last few weeks of this Autumn Term, there is so much to enjoy so let's hope that attendance remains very high!

Parent View Outcomes: We are delighted to report that our questionnaire was completed in a very positive way. We didn't get the number of responses that we normally would with only 18 families completing the survey on this occasion. It was only recently that the vast majority shared their views via the Ofsted inspection feedback link and we were delighted with the outcomes shared with us at that juncture too! The great news is that 100% of families agree that their child is happy at school and safe. There was only a maximum of 1 'not positive' response to a few of the questions and, as always, we would urge any parent with concerns to talk them through with myself or our leadership team. Themes that came up in the general comments were also mostly positive but there were some good questions and comments to help us to move forward in the future. We will share these comments in next week's newsletter and how we intend to explore them further in the near future. Thank you for taking the time to share your views!
