Dear families,

PE Day Reminder:

EYFS: Nursery – Tuesday AM, F2 – Thursday AM

KS1: Year 1 – Tuesday PM and Wednesday AM , Year 2 – Tuesday PM and Friday AM

KS2: Year 3/4 - Monday PM and Tuesday AM, Year 5/6 - Wednesday PM and Thursday PM *

*Please note these days and times for Years 5/6 could change weekly due to staff and weather so can we stress that the children have their PE kits every Monday morning for the week ahead.

Club Safety: Please note that all club drop offs (7.50am) and pick-ups (4.15pm) should be at/from the hall doors or main reception. Last term we had some children running from the doors to their parents who had arrived at the top car park or gates despite it getting dark and being busy. <u>Please note that we have asked that all pupils under Y5/6 will stay with the club leader until the parent reaches the pick-up area.</u> Y5/6 pupils still need to be collected until February half term and then they can walk home again from March onwards. We have notified all club leaders of this plan to ensure the safety of everyone. Please don't park in the school car park to drop/collect from clubs, even if there are spaces, due to insurance reasons.

Assessment Dates and Holidays: A reminder that we would like all parents to avoid term time holidays and absences for non-illness related purposes. Could families in key assessment year groups please be extra careful around the following times:

If your child does not wish to take part in an activity or they cannot attend for any reason please email us and let us know. This will allow more children to get involved and maximise the capacity that we have available to us.
